5.3. OceanaGold Update

Services Trench - Work Beginning this Month



Beginning in August, we'll be installing infrastructure in road reserve along SH25 and Willows Road, just north of Waihi. The pipes will carry water, power, and fibre optic cable between our Waihi operations and company owned property at the end of Willows Road. These services will be essential for building the surface infrastructure associated with the Wharekirauponga Underground Mine – if we gain approval for the proposed Waihi North Project.

We've obtained the necessary approvals from Hauraki District Council and Waikato District Council to undertake this work, which is separate from our <u>Fast-track approvals process</u> for the <u>Waihi North Project</u>. The work is expected to take approximately 12 months to complete, subject to weather conditions and other factors beyond our control.

HOW DOES THIS INTEGRATE WITH THE WAIHI NORTH PROJECT?

While the Waihi North Project remains under consideration as part of the Fast-track approvals process, we're taking proactive steps to ensure we're well positioned to begin work should approvals for that project be granted. By installing the essential services and infrastructure now, we're setting ourselves up to start work quickly if the project is approved. This forward planning allows for a smoother transition between projects and helps maintain momentum across our operations in Waihi.

Waihi North Project update – Invitations for Comment on our Application

The Waihi North Project has moved to the next phase of its approval process under the Fast-track legislation. Invitations have now been sent to selected people or groups for comment on the Waihi North Project. Only the Expert Panel, appointed by the Environmental Protection Authority, can invite comments on the application. As the applicant, OceanaGold doesn't have a role in determining who's asked to provide formal comment.

After receiving some enquiries from people who have received letters, we've engaged an independent Friend of the Commenter who can guide people through the process. As a consultant planner, they're not part of OceanaGold and will provide free, neutral support to help people:

- Understand the Fast-track process
- Identify the parts of the Waihi North Project application that are relevant to your circumstances
- Get clarity on technical reports, if needed, to improve understanding
- Prepare a clear, relevant and effective comment.

6.2. Outdoor Recreation Hub

- Timber benches for pump track update WCF chooses site 1 for 2 x benches request benches without backs (SFW20) so both sides can be used, with metal studs to prevent skaters from grinding and damaging them. HDC will pay for seats and installation.
- BBQ update awaiting quote from HDC for BBQ installation.
- Pump track signage update draft signs to be sent to HDC for their marketing team to refine and brand. Suggested placement of two signs with track diagram on one and code on the other, and sponsors signs on the back of both. To be placed either side of the concrete pathway near the carpark. Suggested stencil signs on the asphalt to point to small track and large track entry points.
- EdO left meeting 18:24
- Playground revitalisation EdO met with Terri Casey HDC and Paul Matthews HDC on 16 July to discuss. Playground fence will remain in place as a safety barrier to stop kids from falling off the retaining wall. Bark will be topped up, and broken equipment will be removed.
- Discuss meeting with HDC about stage 2. BR and AMS met with HDC re WCF funding parameters, and it will be an HDC project. HDC is funding current geotech for the next stages. Resource consent to get preloading done.
